

Vaccination is a condition of participation for World Council

This requirement will be maintained even if it is no longer a requirement in Denmark.



Which vaccines are accepted?



THE DANISH AUTHORITIES CURRENTLY ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING VACCINES:

- Pfizer BioNTech (Comirnaty)
- Johnson & Johnson Janssen Pharmaceutical (COVID-19 Vaccine Janssen)
- Moderna (COVID-19 Vaccine Moderna)
- AstraZeneca (Vaxzevria, formerly COVID-19 Vaccine AstraZeneca).
- Novavax (Nuvaxovid)
- Covishield
- Covaxin
- Sinovac
- Sinopharm


Proof of full vaccination



Delegates must be able to present relevant documentation that they are fully vaccinated. The EU Digital COVID Certificate for vaccination, is also sufficient. The Vaccination certificate must contain:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Name of the vaccine
- Date of completion: dates of the 1st and 2nd jabs (for a vaccination process requiring 2 jabs) as well as date of revaccination if one has been received.

Delegates coming from regions with variants of concern within the past 10 days are not exempt from the requirement for testing and isolation after entry, however <u>currently there</u> are no such countries, regions or areas).



Arrival in Denmark



All Participants are requested to check specific requirements for arrival in Denmark from their country, as the country you arrive from defines if you must take a test and self-isolate in Denmark:

Testing

Covid testing is currently free of charge in Denmark. All participants will be given a self test to take when they arrive in Aarhus. If further Covid testing is considered necessary throughout World Council, this will also be arranged for Conference participants.

Mask wearing

Mask wearing is encouraged throughout the conference. If necessary, the wearing of face masks during the conference will be made obligatory. Masks will be provided by the World Council Team.

Space utilisation

The Music House Conference Centre is a world class conference and performance venue, with sanitisation points available throughout. It is subject to regular hygiene cleaning. It takes all possible measures - in line with the directives of the Danish Health Authorities - to ensure a safe and secure conference.

Distancing and participant flow will be managed within the Conference Centre, which is large enough to allow sufficient space between seats in the auditorium, if necessary.

Returning home



Returning to countries of departure

Currently, travellers who need a negative Covid test before boarding their flights home may have a free Covid test in Denmark.

Each participant is responsible for understanding the conditions of re-entry to their return destination.

All participants should have travel health insurance.
