YMCA USA Food Assistance Programs

From September 2020 through February 2021, 1,254 YMCAs participated in serving food across more than 11,000 distribution sites. Food boxes were distributed nationwide to those in need between March 2020 and February 2021. For context, the average person eats between 3-5 pounds of food a day.

In the Fall and Winter seasons of 2020-2021, the Y helped feed more than 1.2 million people across the country. Altogether during the pandemic year from March 2020- February 2021, Ys served over 56 million meals and snacks to children, families and seniors. **#YMCAcommunitywellbeing**

YMCA Victoria (Australia) Rebuild Second Chance Employment

ReBuild is a social enterprise that supports young people involved in the criminal justice system with a pathway to employment and reintegration back into the community. Focusing on reducing the rates of reoffending, ReBuild provides training, mentoring, employment and support to provide these young people with a second chance. A commercial maintenance business, ReBuild offers a range of landscaping, landscape maintenance, carpentry and building work across the Melbourne region.

The reoffending rate in young people who do Rebuild, drops from over 50% to just 3%. **#YMCAmeaningfulwork**

The YMCA provides subsidised medications including essential mental health items to vulnerable populations, based on an approved Essential Chronic Medication list, updated every 3 years in consultation with WHO and the Ministry of Public Health .



YMCA England & Wales Support & Advice

YMCA provides support and advice to almost 72,000 young people every year. This includes employment and careers advice, mentoring, mental health advice and counselling, sexual health advice, drug and alcohol advice and counselling, crime prevention and avoidance programmes, welfare and benefits advice, housing advice and food banks.

We also run the Y's Girls mentoring programme which matches trained volunteer mentors with young women aged 9-14 years old to support them to be their best. In the first nine months of delivery 206 volunteer mentors and 268 mentees were recruited, trained and on-boarded, and the project's success has led to it being renewed for another year.

Zimbabwe YMCA **Enhanced Entrepreneurship and Enterprise Hub**

Enhanced Entrepreneurship and Enterprise Hub trains two groups of young people. The first is those who have not had businesses or livelihood opportunities before.

The second is those who started micro-businesses but lost scale, resources and financial capacity due to the pandemic. The project takes place in Karoma and Bulawayo. 100 young people aged 15-35 (40 male and 50 female, including 10 young people living with disabilities) receive intensive support to create and manage income-generating businesses. **#YMCAmeaningfulwork**



Running for over 35 years now, the program has seen over 10,000 participants to date. #YMCAjustworld






The project was spearheaded by YMCA Project Bridge in July 2011 and aimed to equip out-of-school youth and youth-at-risk between 14 to 21 years old, with specific vocational skills which they can put to use in a job immediately.

These courses aim to train youth in skills that are necessary for them to pursue a career, courses offered are in the following areas: baking, barista, culinary, enrichment culinary assistant (pre-school), events manager (sports industry), fishing (fishing and boat repairts), hairdressing, hospitality and media production (filming). **#YMCAmeaningfulwork**
